Training Property Guidelines

Welcome to the Sand Hills of South Carolina. We believe we have some of the best pre-National training grounds offered to prepare you and your dog for the big show. H. Cooper Black sporting dog facility has acted as a magnet to bring retriever enthusiasts from around the East Coast down to South Carolina to develop properties in the surrounding area. Most of these properties are located within an hour's drive of HCB. When you see these property owners, please give them a smile and a thank you. They have made their grounds available for your training pleasure, so please respect their property as if it were your own.

The drawing for these training grounds will be held at the headquarters – Hampton Inn in Hartsville, South Carolina at 6 pm beginning Sunday, November 7 through Thursday, November 11. During the field trial, training properties will be on a first come first served basis.

- Areas are open from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- Please remove all trash and NEVER leave birds behind. Dispose of birds at designated sites.
- No smoking out of vehicles.
- Please stay on roads and only use ATVs in fields and around ponds.
- Do not exceed 10 mph on ATVs- no exceptions.
- Don't get stuck. If grounds are wet be careful and avoid any boggy areas.
- Do not shoot in the direction of visible livestock, residences, or heavily traveled roads.
- Leave gates the way you find them
- Follow additional guidelines for individual properties

COVID-19 Guidelines

Congratulations on qualifying for the 2021 National Retriever Championship.

The 2021 National Retriever Championship will operate in accordance with the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control Guidelines for Mass Gatherings, the CDC Considerations for Events and Gatherings and the American Kennel Club Suggested Best Practices for the Well-Being of Dog Sport Participants.

Anyone attending this event will be doing so at their own risk. People who have a health condition or are taking medications that weaken their immune system may not be fully protected even if they are fully vaccinated. • Areas are open from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

- Please do not attend if you are sick, have pending COVID-19 test results or have been in close contact with someone who has pending COVID-19 test results.
- The CDC recommends unvaccinated persons wear masks for indoor gatherings of any size.
- Practice social distancing of at least six feet distance to the greatest extent possible.
- Wash hands frequently (20 seconds with soap and water or use of a sanitizer).
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects.
- Strongly cover mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze and throw away used tissues immediately.
- Instructions for the safe handling and delivery of birds will be given at the General Meeting.
- Additional face masks and hand sanitizers are available on the grounds.
- Any person displaying symptoms must contact the COVID Coordinator and immediately self-isolate.
- Please socially distance from the NRC judges at all times.

1. If an individual is determined to be sick, needs a COVID test or has been exposed to someone who is a presumptive positive, the COVID-19 Coordinator should determine and document who the individual should notify and the next steps to be taken.

2. Inform all competition volunteers, service providers, participants and support personnel that if any individual who was present on the competition grounds tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the conclusion of the event, that individual must immediately notify the COVID-19 Coordinator.

3. COVID-19 Coordinator must notify all competition volunteers, service providers, participants and support personnel if any individual who was present on the competition grounds tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the conclusion of the competition.

4. Any person suspected to have COVID-19 or similar symptoms needs to be quickly removed from the competition grounds (or isolated on-site until they can arrange transportation) to avoid further contact with other individuals.

5. If an individual on the grounds is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 and is unable to travel independently and immediately away from the competition grounds, the individual must be asked to remain in an isolation area away from others until private transportation can be organized.

6. If an individual on the grounds is displaying symptoms of COVID-19, contact tracing will be used to determine anyone who has been in close contact with the isolated individual. Close contact defined as any of the following:

a. Having been within six (6) feet of an individual for at least 15 minutes, starting from 48 hours before that person began feeling sick until the time that individual was isolated

b. Having had direct physical contact with the isolated individual

c. Having shared eating or drinking utensils

d. Those who have been within close contact of the isolated individual will also be put into isolation and removed from the competition grounds.

7. Any individual displaying symptoms of COVID-19 must be tested negative for the virus prior to returning to the Field Trial Grounds.

8. If an individual who has been vaccinated has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, they do not need to quarantine, but should wear a mask. Tested is required is that vaccinated person develops symptoms.

9. It is recommended that a person get tested 5-7 days after exposure to confirmed COVID-19, however, due to the nature of the NRC, a negative test from someone who has been exposed will be accepted at any time following the exposure to return to the grounds.

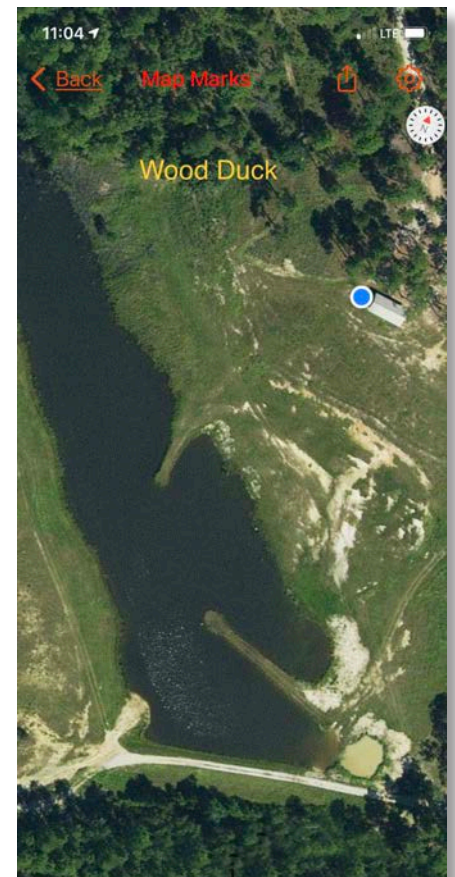
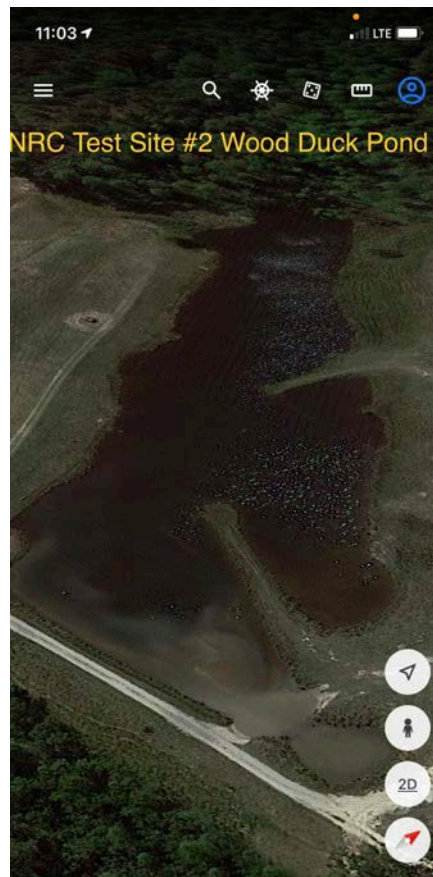
Palmetto Field is a large 115 acre grassland field interspersed with blackjack oaks, hay bales and large swaths of broom straw. It is covered by low rolling hills which provide a variable terrain component. This field is conducive to long marks.



Test Site #2 – Wood Duck Pond

H. Cooper Black, J. Memorial Field Trial Area

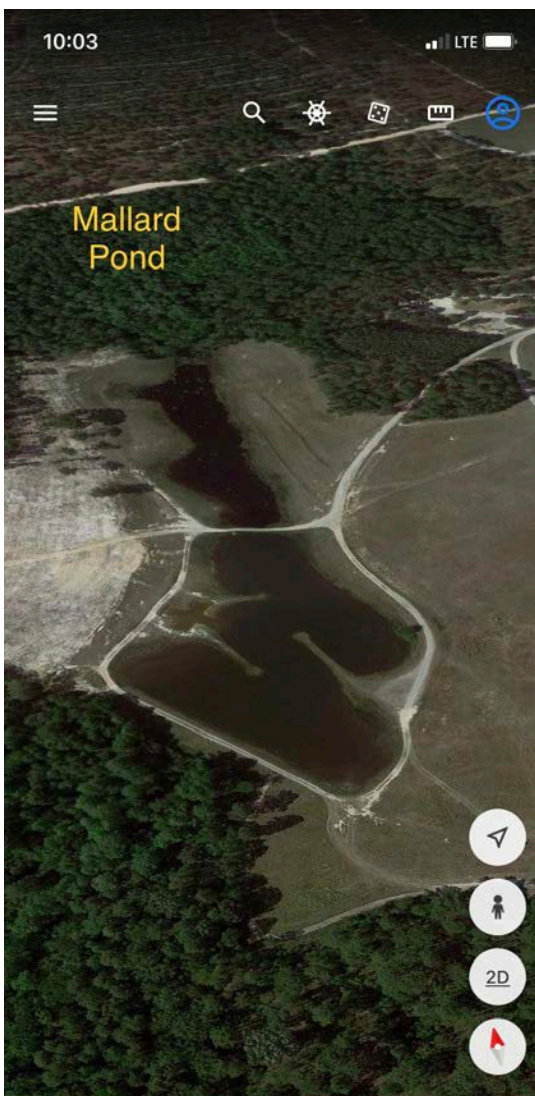
NRC Test Site #2, Wood Duck Pond is a black water pond with spits and rolling grassland hills surrounding this narrow creek-fed pond.



Test Site #3 – Mallard Pond

H. Cooper Black, J. Memorial Field Trial Area

Mallard Pond is a wonderful double pond divided by a roadway between the upper and lower ponds. The upper pond is dotted with tree stumps and standing trees and the lower pond has three spits. There are rolling grasslands on either side of the pond making for long, water entries and long, down and out birds.



Test Sites #4&5 – Goose Pond-A&B

Approximately 85 acres divided into Goose Pond A and Goose Pond B. NRC Test Sites #4 & #5 consist of a large rolling grass field sloping down into a large pond with several spits. This is actually three ponds divided by two dams. Plenty of opportunities for long swims or long up and outs.

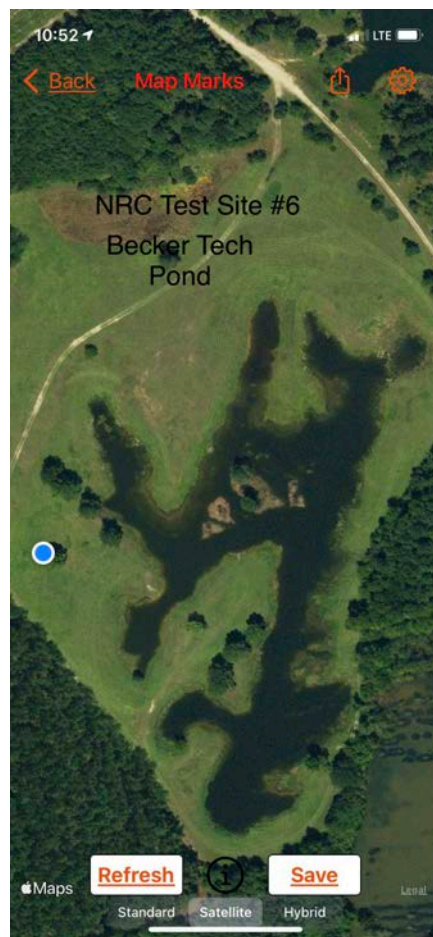
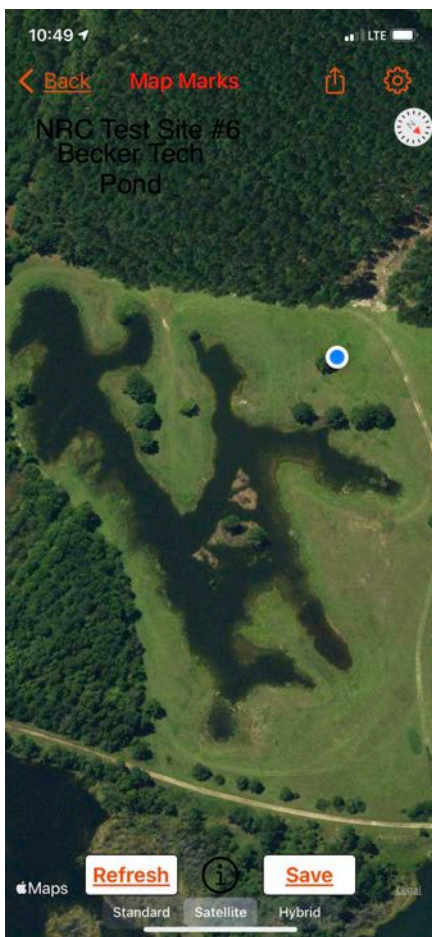


Test Site #6 – Becker Technical Pond

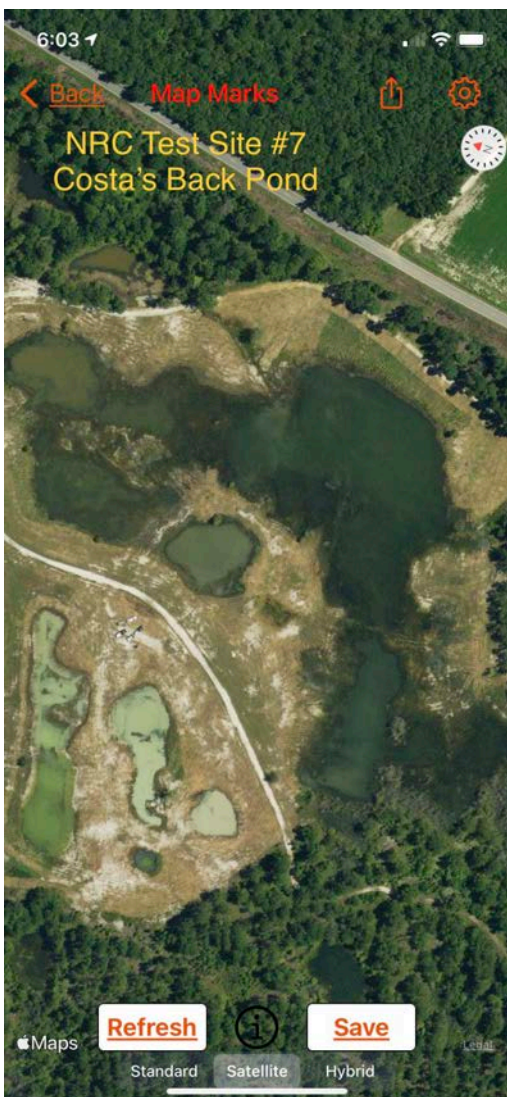
It's an extremely usable pond from 360° with multiple spits, channels and islands. It has long water entries from many angles. It is a retriever trainer's dream pond!

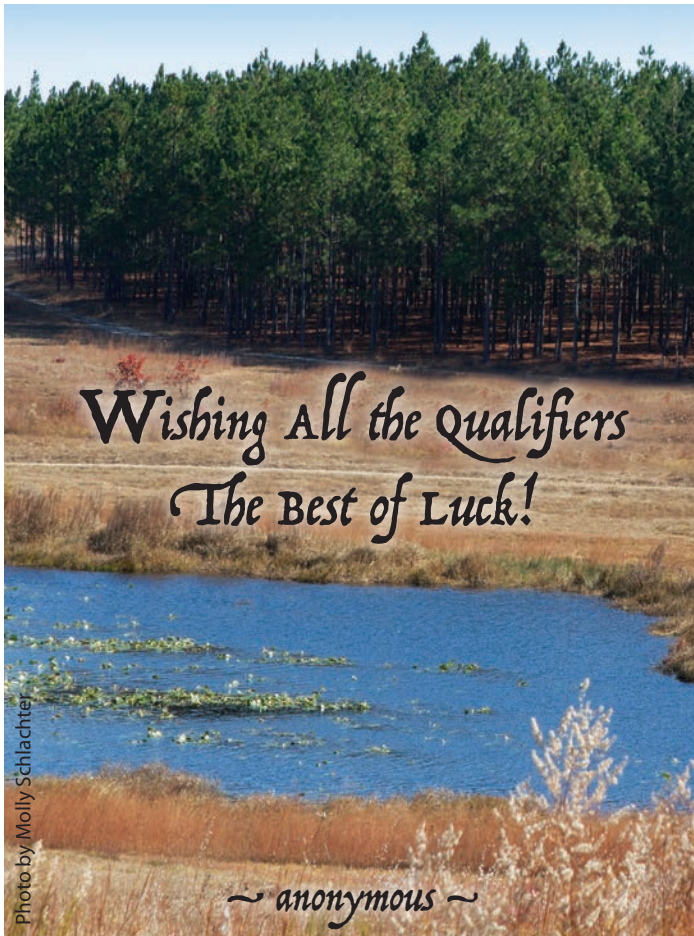


Test Site #8 – Costa Cypress Pond

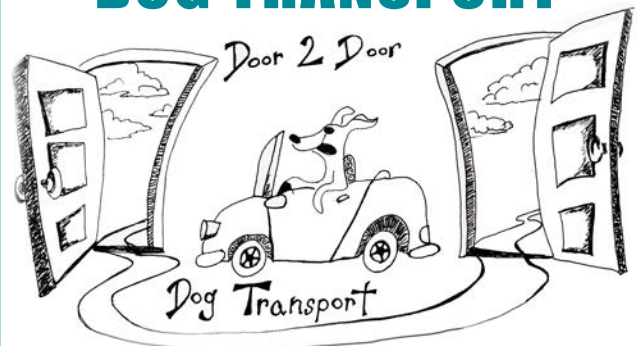

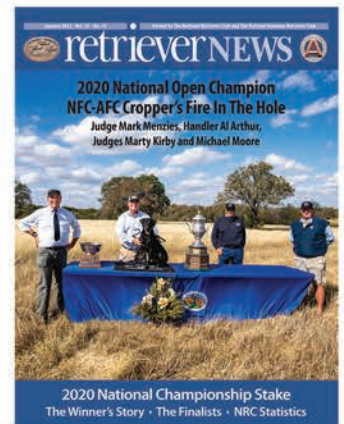
