FC-AFC Lanes Lets Get Ready To Rumble, “Ali,” was the same dog, day after day, whether he was training or competing. He loved to train and was always a team player that wanted to please. He ran his blinds as hard as he did going for a shot flyer. His marking and memory were uncanny. Ali’s disposition was always the same, no matter if he was in the field or in the house. He had no problem looking out over big water and making a big swim under tough conditions.

Ali started his career early, winning his first Derby at 13 months old against 29 other contenders. He ended his Derby career with 30 Derby points in limited outings, He won two Qualifying stakes in back-to-back weekends and had his first All-Age placement before he was 3 years old. He got his FC-AFC title at Chattanooga at 3 by winning the Open and placing second in the Amateur with Bobby handling. This win and second qualified him for the National Open and Amateur that year.

He qualified for his 13th National at almost 11 years old when he won a 49-dog Amateur and placed third in a 69-dog Open stake. Ali competed successfully for over 10 years with no injuries or health issues. Ali’s looks, abilities and competitiveness have been passed on to his offspring. He has produced 8 Field Champions, 7 Amateur Field Champions, 2 Canadian Field Champions, 2 Canadian Amateur Field Champions, 64 Qualifying All-Age dogs, 33 Master Hunters and several offspring that have finished Nationals. Notables at the Nationals have been FC-AFC Lane’s Thrilla N Manilla, “Frazier,” FC Vinwood’s Million Dollar Baby, “Babe,” and FC-AFC Trumarc’s Mavis, “Mavis.” His legacy lives on.
