FC-AFC Double Header Nodrog Penny qualified for nine Nationals and was a Finalist in the 1996 Spokane National Amateur Trial. The Rocky Mountain Association (consisting of 11 clubs) had three traveling trophies, two of which Penny retired after winning each three times. In her field trial career, she averaged 1.1 points in the Open and 1.6 points in the Amateur. Penny was amateur trained and handled and was pulled from other competition after qualifying for the Nationals each year. She loved hunting – pheasants, ducks, grouse, and geese. She knew the difference between hunting and field trials. At age 10 she had a heart attack at a trial while retrieving a mark. She was then retired and lived as a wonderful house companion until she died at 15 years, 2 months. A super, super wonderful dog! A great trial dog – very exiciting to watch.
