Sire of thirteen titled dogs. Among these titled offspring were the 1976 High Point Derby, FC-AFC Carr Lab-Raiders Gain, FC-AFC Carr-Lab's Washington's Weeko, FC-AFC Crook's Pork And Beans, FC-AFC Raider's Piper Cub and the 1976 NFC-AFC San Joaquin Honcho.
