Jack Vollstedt acquired "Ruff" as a seven-week-old puppy from breeder, Ralph Ricci. Jack did all his training except for a seven and a half month period spent with Dana Brown. Records show he sired eleven titled offspring. He was not on the Derby list, but is shown with 106 Open points and 39.5 Amateur points for 145.5 All-Age points in his career.

The time period of 1980 through 1987, Ruff qualified for 7 National Opens (every year except 1983). He was a National Open Finalist in 1980, 1981 and 1982. Ruff also qualified for 4 National Amateurs in 1980, 1981, 1982 and 1983 – though he was never a Finalist. He did compete in 80% of the stakes for those years.

John DeSimone purchased Ruff from Jack Vollstedt in 1984. From 1984 until his death (1989), Ruff was handled by Jim Swan.

Volwood's Ruff And Reddy was elected to the Retriever Hall of Fame in the year 2000.
